This Professional Learning session is designed to assist pre-service teachers’ transition into professional teaching roles. Arts educators often work in small single teacher departments; without Arts-based colleagues to connect with directly in order to develop professional learning communities to plan, assess and moderate. In order to support pre-service teachers in their transition from study to the classroom, this professional learning opportunity proposes to connect pre-service teachers with exemplary teachers.

If you are an experienced teacher, or an early career teacher, please come prepared to share resources and knowledge in the following topics:

- Unit and lesson plans
- Differentiated tasks: what works, and building students’ numeracy and literacy capabilities
- Inclusion strategies for students with a disability
- Resources: anything you find useful for your day-to-day organisation or classroom ICT
- Using the General Capabilities to enact the DoE goals of Access, Participation and Engagement
- How to work with the Australian Curriculum; and using the Curriculum to assess and create rubrics

It is hoped that these topics will allow pre-service and graduate teachers to collect valuable resources and knowledge, gain an understanding on solid strategies that have been tried and tested, and provide a space where they can get some answers to any burning questions. This PL will also be highly valuable for mentor-teachers and professional experience colleague teachers.
